RE: Resolution Favoring Construction of a New Courthouse Facility

TO THE HONORABLE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE PORTAGE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Whereas, Portage County has undertaken several studies (Goldman, Venture) which detail the physical and ergonomic issues with the present courthouse (built in 1958) and which highlight significant security issues for the court operations in the present facility as well as significant problems with the obsolescence of the space and functions in using the present facility; and

Whereas the present facility is severely limited in the capacity to expand for future operations, including functions and interactions with county and city operations, and


Whereas this resolution constitutes a "sense of the board" favoring the concept of the building of a replacement courthouse.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Portage County Board of Supervisors recognizes the need for and favors the construction of a new replacement court building, the details of that construction, including size, location, costs, and financing, to be the topic of future resolutions.
