

NOTICE OF ADVISORY REFERENDUM
PORTAGE COUNTY

AMENDED

By law, the electors of Portage County shall consider the following advisory referendum question in the election of April 6th, 2010.

Shall Portage County construct a new two story courthouse of approximately 93,350 square feet in the downtown Stevens Point area as a facility connected to the present Portage County Annex and existing Law Enforcement Center at a capital cost not to exceed twenty-nine million five hundred thousand dollars (\$29,500,000)?

EXPLANATION

A "YES" vote means that you are in favor of building a new courthouse facility for Portage County in the downtown Stevens Point area to include new courtrooms and related offices, built to code and security standards, with offices for the Clerk of Courts, Judges, and Child Support, along with the reutilization of existing space and county buildings for the District Attorney and other county offices.

A "NO" vote means you do not favor the construction of a new courthouse facility as described above.
