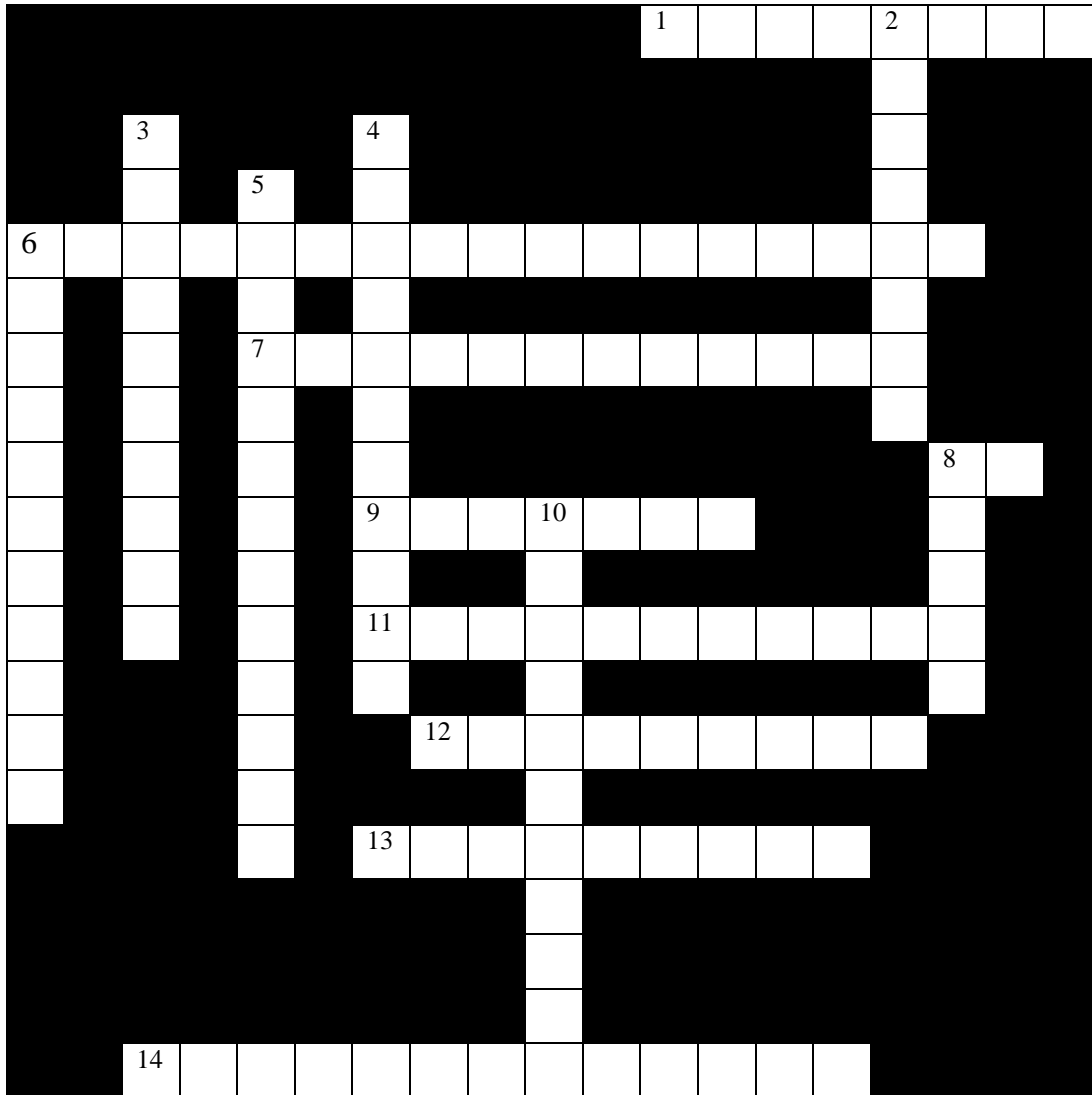


Groundwater Crossword
