- ◆ A dog license is required by Wisconsin State Law
- ◆ A fine of up to \$263.50 can be charged for an unlicensed dog
- ◆ A license helps your lost dog get home faster

Wisconsin State Law requires that all dogs 5 months of age or older, be licensed and have an active certificate of proof of rabies vaccination from a licensed veterinarian prior to April 1st every year. A Certificate of proof of current vaccination must be presented when obtaining a license. Puppies must be licensed on or before they reach 5 months of age. Newly-acquired dogs over 5 months of age must be licensed within 30 days. A late fee will be assessed for licenses purchased after this time frame. Owners of unlicensed dogs are subject to a fine up to \$263.50 per unlicensed dog.
