

Planning and Zoning Department staff assisted the Stevens Point Urban Area Sewer Service Advisory Committee in revising and updating the 1983 Urban Area Sewer Service Area Plan. The Advisory Committee is made up of representatives from the municipal governments of Stevens Point, the Villages of Plover, Whiting, and Park Ridge, and the Towns of Hull, Plover, Linwood, and Stockton. The current Chair of the Committee is Elmer Fournier from the Village of Park Ridge; Vice-Chair is Dan Schlutter from the Village of Plover.

An Open House and Public Hearing were held on November 14, 2007 to receive comments and feedback from residents regarding the draft Stevens Point Urban Area Areawide Water Quality Management Plan 2007 - 2027 Update (also known as the Sewer Service Plan). At the regular Advisory Committee meeting that followed the Open House and Public Hearing, the Committee voted to adopt the Stevens Point Urban Area Sewer Service Plan, which was forwarded to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for their review and approval. WDNR granted this approval on October 22, 2008.

Chapter 1 of the Plan explains the purpose for Sewer Service Area planning. Appendix E contains the By-Laws under which this Committee operates.
