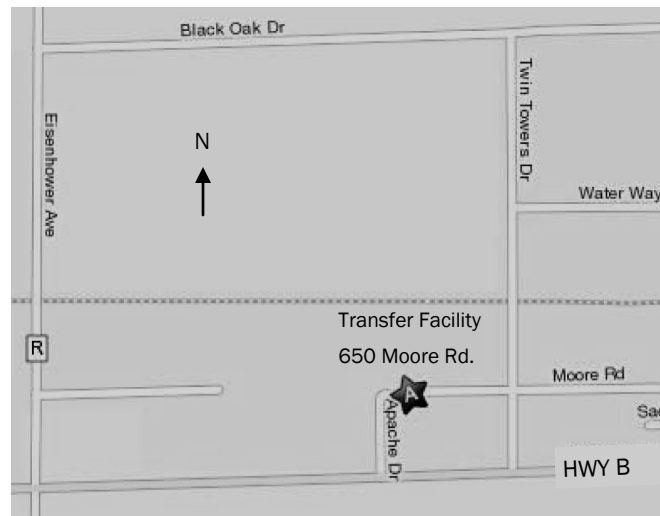

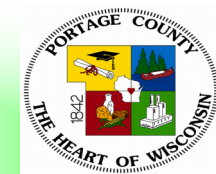

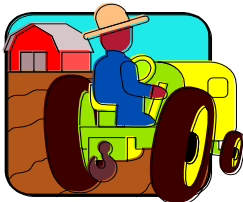
BUSINESS / INSTITUTION VERY SMALL QUANTITY GENERATOR (VSQGs)

~ **HOUSEHOLD FEES** ~
(Prices subject to change)

Oil based paints, solvents, gas, cleaners, fertilizers, pesticides, aerosols, etc.

\$7.50 minimum for 10 pounds or less

\$0.75 for each additional pound.

Liquid Latex Paint

(or see latex paint instructions)

\$1.50 per pound

Mercury

(must be in original device)

\$3.00 per pound (\$3.00 minimum fee)

~ **Safe Use of Hazardous Materials** ~

- * Purchase only the amount needed
- * Look for/use less-toxic alternatives
- * Give away usable leftovers

~ **Manage Latex Paint Yourself** ~

Latex paint is **NOT** a hazardous material.
Use this method for easy disposal.

To harden paint, leave can open **or** pour it into a box lined with a plastic bag.

To speed up the process, add kitty litter, sawdust or a commercially-purchased hardener.

Leave the lid off of the can (it can be recycled).

Toss hardened paint into trash.

Remember: Buy the minimum amount needed for projects. Use old latex paint for craft projects or see if friends or neighbors want the paint.
