Delivering to the Transfer Facility

The Solid Waste Transfer Facility is open to the public and accepts many types of waste and recyclables.

- **All loads must be covered or enclosed!**
Uncovered loads will be refused and drivers will be cited.
- **All loads are weighed** upon arrival.
Stop at scale and register!
- Ask attendant for information on where to unload and follow signs.
- After unloading materials, return to scale & weigh-in again.
Stop at the scale office to make payment.
Violators will be cited.

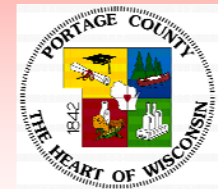
Hazardous Materials

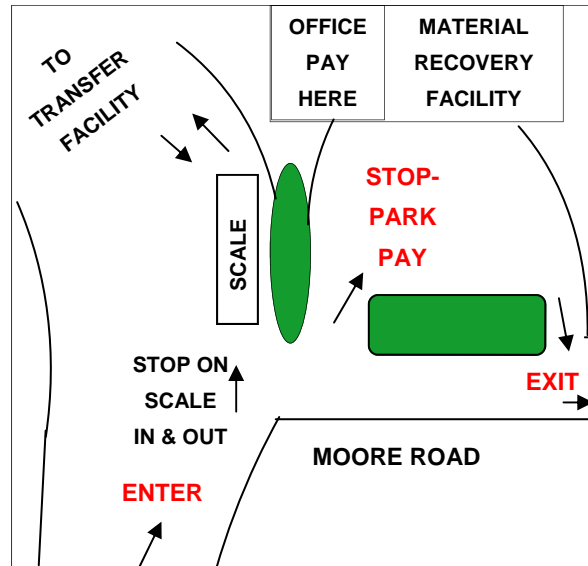

The NEW Solid Waste Transfer Facility (SWTF) is located about one mile east of I-39 and Cty. Hwy B (Exit 153) in the Village of Plover. Turn north on Apache Drive. The NEW Solid Waste Transfer Facility is on Moore Road west of the Material Recovery Facility.
