New Transfer Facility offers efficient service

With the closure of the Portage County Sanitary Landfill in May 2007, the solid waste needs of the county are met with the newly-constructed Transfer Facility. The facility, located in Plover off of Cty. Hwy. B next to the County's Material



Recovery Facility, is a convenient drop-off site for residents, businesses and commercial haulers regularly at the Transfer Facility.

All facility customers unload their items against the back (northern) tipping wall, which is reinforced concrete. County employees then use heavy machinery to move the solid waste from the tipping wall

into semi-trailers for transportation to neighboring counties' landfills, with which Portage County has a contract.

The Transfer Facility is capable of processing up to 100 tons of solid waste. Employees quickly process and ship out incoming materials to meet municipal requirements.

In addition to solid waste materials, other items accepted include recyclables like electronics and tires.

Drop-off is an easy process

It is simple to drop off your solid waste materials at the Transfer Facility.

First, just stop at the scale in between the facility and the Material Recovery Facility. Tell the scale attendant what items you have and wait for his or her directions. Drop off your items,

and return to the scale so the attendant can determine the weight of your materials. Finally, head into the scale office to pay for your materials.

And cheap, too!

The cost of many items dropped off at the facility are determined by weight, while others have a flat fee associated with them. Please call the Solid Waste Department for more information.
