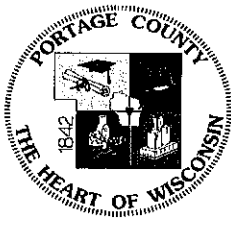

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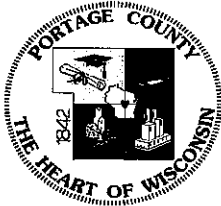

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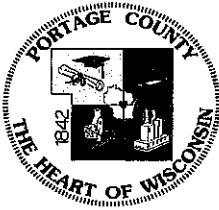
Portage County Solid Waste Management Board Meeting Minutes Monday, April 29, 2019

- 1) **Call to order:** Chair Schlutter called the meeting to order at 5 pm
- 2) **Roll Call:** Holdridge, Zastrow, Honl, Schlutter, Medin, Zach, Neville, Wiza; Excused: Miresse;
Others Present: Amanda Haffele (Solid Waste Director); Jeff Zillich (Advanced Disposal); Stephanie Finamore (Mi-Tech); Al Haga (County Board Chair); Chris Holman (County Executive)

- 4) **Approve minutes:** Zastrow moves to approve minutes as amended to include Solid Waste Staff in attendance and to correct a spelling error. Wiza seconds; motion carries.

Prices are going down across the board. Waste Management has agreed to purchase ADS between now and first quarter of next year. Small discussion by board about what needs to happen before they can acquire the company. Zillich to get back to board on new aluminum plant in Wi Rapids.
 - iv. **Solid Waste Site Coordinator Reported by Solid Waste Director**

PerMar performed the annual PM on the MRF security system. Valley Scale performed the annual calibration check on the landfill scale. Volumes remain strong at Transfer Facility and are comparable to last year. Lodzinski has received most of the results from the March sampling at the landfill and all are good. Medin requested the number of truck loads be added to Lodzinski report so they can what the average is.
 - v. **Solid Waste Director**

Class on Public, Private, Partnerships was worth going to. Participants had discussion and assignments around tips for running a success partnership. SWAP report is not attached to this month's board packet because of a discrepancy between Advanced Disposal's numbers and the County's. A corrected version will be in May's packet. Portage County isn't sure how the Waste Management merger will affect the County until probably next year around this time. Another load cell was replaced on the scale, making that a total of 3 loads cells since the beginning of this year. Two of the pucks will need to be replaced in May, causing the scale to be down an hour earlier



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than normal one day in May. State Statue 59.70(2) was included in the board packet for reference to all new board members and as a reminder to everyone else where our duties come from.

- 10) **Landfill Long-term account update**
Haffele followed up with the County Executive and expressed the board's concern over the possible movement of the LTC account and had a brief conference call with US Bank and the Finance Director. US Bank will charge the SWMB a fee to invest the monies, which equates to approximately \$3,000/year. A list of our investments and our budget that has been approved by the WI DNR was sent to US Bank to guide future discussions. They will attend the July board meeting to speak with the board. Haffele will also invite Baird to attend this meeting as well. During the March meeting the board expressed concern on who has the final say in moving the funds. Possible clarity could come from State Statue 59.70(2)(L); Haffele is waiting on Corp Counsel to clarify this part of the State Statue. Discussion by board, County Executive, and County Board Chair.
- 11) **MRF RFP update**
The RFP went out on April 8th. The Mandatory Meeting was held at the MRF on April 18th. Six different companies were represented during this meeting. RFPs are due back to Purchasing on May 17th with a notification of intent to award sent out the week of June 3rd. Wiza motions to have Haffele speak with Purchasing to include an addendum in the RFP to clarify that proposers should include any cost savings as an alternative if they were to win the bid for Transfer Facility operations and MRF operations. Zach seconds, motion carries.

- 13) **Adjournment:** Zastrow moves to end and Schluter seconds, motion carries. Adjourned at 5:50 pm.
