An Ordinance to adopt the amended 2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton

The Town Board of the Town of Stockton Ordains as Follows:

Section 1

Pursuant to Section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes the Town of Stockton is authorized to prepare and amend a Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Stockton as defined in Section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes and has been working cooperatively with the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department in amending the 2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton.

Section 2

The Town Plan Commission of the Town of Stockton, by a majority vote of the entire Commission has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board, adoption of an amended 2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton.

Section 3

The Town Board held a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the 2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton on September 13, 2016, in compliance with the requirements of Section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 4

The Town Board of the Town of Stockton, Portage County, Wisconsin, does by enactment of this Ordinance, formally adopt the amendments to the document formerly titled "2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton" pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c) of Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 5

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the Town Board and publication as required by law, and the 2006 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Stockton shall be amended as deemed appropriate by the Town Board.
