### **SPRING NONPARTISAN ELECTION AND STATE REFERENDUM**

On April 3, 2018 Portage County will have a Countywide Spring Nonpartisan Election for Justice of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals-District 4, Portage County Circuit Court Judges-Branches 1 & 3, and County Executive. There will also be a Statewide Referendum regarding the Elimination of the State Treasurer. There will be a County Board Supervisor election in all 25 County Board Supervisor Districts-please refer to the Supervisor District Boundaries and Reporting Units. If a primary is necessary, the primary election would be held February 20, 2018.

Results will be entered live after the polls close at 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
