### **Click-it or Ticket Campaign Starts This Week Increased Enforcement Efforts for Seat Belts Stresses Safety**

To kick off the 2018 “Click It or Ticket” seat belt campaign, the Portage County Sheriff’s Office is partnering with law enforcement partners across the Nation, and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to highlight the dangers of not wearing a seat belt.

From May 21 to June 3, law enforcement across Wisconsin will patrol with a special emphasis on enforcing seat belt and other traffic safety laws to help prevent traffic-related injuries and deaths. During the annual initiative, WisDOT will utilize designated federal dollars to fund enhanced law enforcement patrols and public outreach about seat belt use.

This seat belt enforcement period begins today and runs through June 3, covering the busy Memorial Day holiday weekend. Deputies and other law enforcement officers will be on the lookout for aggressive driving and seat belt violations in particular.
