Election information and results for the up-coming Election will be provided. This election will be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. Portage County will have a County-wide Election consisting of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, United States Senator, Representative in Congress – District 3, the respective Assembly Districts – listed below, and County Offices-Sheriff and Clerk of Circuit Court. There are 3 County-wide referendum questions regarding 1) exceeding levy limits for Health Care Center, 2) Closing Dark Store Loopholes and 3) Use of Medical Marijuana. There are 2 referendum questions for the Stevens Point Area Public School District regarding 1) exceeding revenue limit for recurring operating costs and 2) issuance of general obligation bonds. There is 1 local referendum for the Town of Amherst regarding 1) having the office of Town Clerk and Town Treasurer appointed by the town board.
