Resolution to adopt the Town of Carson Comprehensive Plan

The Town Plan Commission of the Town of Carson Resolves as Follows:

WHEREAS, Section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes set out the requirements for long-range Comprehensive planning for towns, villages, and cities across the State; and


WHEREAS, Section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes authorizes the Plan Commission to prepare, amend and recommend a Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Carson; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Carson Plan Commission began working cooperatively with the Portage County Planning and Zoning Department in updating the formerly titled "2004 Comprehensive Plan, Town of Carson" in October of 2012; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Carson completed a comprehensive update to the 2004 Plan including data from the 2010 Decennial Census and American Community Survey, updated information related to transportation, utilities and community facilities, agricultural and natural resources, economic development, intergovernmental cooperation, and amendments to the criteria used to map natural areas resulting in changes to the Town's Future Land Use map; and


