6. Summary of Current Actions

March 23, 2020 18:00

Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 5. No positive cases confirmed.

Testing of individuals continues based on 4-tiered testing criteria established by DHS on 03/19/2020.

Community widespread transmission established in Brown, Columbia, Dane, Fond u lac, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Walworth, and Waukesha counties in WI.

Additional states in the United States identified as sustaining community transmission.

Follow-up by EH staff on complaints related to 10 or people gathered at local restaurants from the weekend.

PCHHS-DPH Operations team activities:

- Timely entry of PIF/PUI forms
- Monitoring symptoms of Portage County residents at medium to high risk and tested for COVID-19
- Providing guidance to the community
- Monitor for test results reported in WEDSS.

Community discussion: long-term care/CBRF facilities, EMS, and medical partners in responding to COVID-19

DHS Daily Health Officer Forum Call.

Work is being done to identify an isolation facility in Portage County.

Fielding lots of calls related to definition of what an “essential service” is from the community.

“Volunteers Rock Program” through United Ways 211 seeking volunteers.

Additional social media messaging released on PCHHS-DPH’s Facebook page related to sheltering in place and taking care of yourself.
