6. Summary of Current Actions

March 27, 2020 16:00

Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 9. Team meeting 08:45. 1 Positive Case.

Testing of individuals continues based on 4-tiered testing criteria established by DHS on 03/19/2020. Priority set for testing of individuals in tier I and tier II.

The DHS outbreaks website will no longer include updates on community spread. It is preferred to say that COVID-19 is spreading throughout Wisconsin.

Additional states in the United States identified as sustaining community transmission.

PCHHS-DPH Operations team activities:

- Timely entry of PIF/PUI forms
- Monitoring symptoms of Portage County residents at medium to high risk and tested for COVID-19
- Providing guidance to the community
- Monitor for test results reported in WEDSS.
- PH intake calls lower at volume.
