Portage County's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) expanded its efforts today in order to further dovetail the county's overall response with the work that has been ongoing at the Portage County Division of Public Health. This coordinated effort ensures that the Division of Public Health is getting the support it needs now and into the future as we work through the public health emergency. It also puts the county into a better position overall to respond to the various ways in which COVID-19 has impacted county operations.
