6. Summary of Current Actions

Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 13. 2 Positive Cases.

Testing of individuals continues based on 4-tiered testing criteria established by DHS on 03/19/2020. Priority set for testing of individuals in tier I and tier II.

WI DHS has released the COVID-19 Voluntary Isolation Site Operation Manual.

Local Public health will be receiving test swabs should the need arise (DHS did not specify a quantity).

PCHHS-DPH team activities:

- Receiving 5-10 Patient Information Forms (PIF) per day. Indication testing is still occurring on Tier 1-Tier 3 clients. Monitoring symptoms of Portage County residents at medium to high risk and tested for COVID-19
- Providing guidance to the community
- Call load has decreased significantly.
- Guidance given to Mental health regarding PPE use

PH DOC Community Call at 9:00AM

- PH Liaison officer will reach out to Amish community Elder in Milladore to assess needs of the community/families
- UWSP is working on respite care sites for HCW
- Marshfield lab is doing internal testing

DHS Received contract for isolation facility in Portage County. Waiting on contract clarification regarding facility rental/use agreement and hold harmless policy.
