6. Summary of Current Actions

April 2, 2020 @ 1800 PM

Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 14. 3 Positive Cases.

Testing of individuals continues based on 4-tiered testing criteria established by DHS on 03/19/2020. Priority set for testing of individuals in tier I and tier II.

PCHHS-DPH team activities:

- Training of additional staff for PIF/PUI WEDSS entry and contact tracing.
- Updates to PUI email body, note and script for testing with current guidance
- PH intake busy with complaints and questions about notification of cases.
- One positive case reported.
- Call load increased significantly for COVID-19 testing.

PH ICS briefing at 0845

Conference call with City of Stevens Point leaders regarding cease and desist orders for non-essential businesses and businesses for which complaints are received at 1030

PH Liaison officer working with LTC and CBRF facilities for establishing isolation and quarantine procedures.

DHS COVID-19 Daily Update for Local and Tribal Health Departments

DHS Clinical Call Forum at 1400.

- DHS met with tribal nations similar COVID-19 related concerns as LHDs
- Use of telehealth now recommended for most medical consults
- Discussion of probable cases
- Discussion and concerns regarding outdoor events like camping, golfing, drive-in church, and "Friday Night Lights" recognition. More messaging needed regarding non-essential travel

DHS Received contract for isolation facility in Portage County – concerns regarding requested "rental rate" for facility use. Waiting on clarification for less use.

Media release regarding 3rd positive case in Portage County.

Working with Portage County HCC to assist with fit-testing for staff wearing N-95s masks

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing, use Skype and telephone as much as possible.
