Note from the County Executive on Governor Evers call for a special session of the legislature to take up changes on the upcoming spring election:

Clerks around the state learned this afternoon that [Governor Evers has called for a special session](#) of the legislature to take up changes to the upcoming spring election. Preparations for the April 7th election were in full swing, calls for poll workers have been put out, and an all-hands-on-deck approach had initiated several important processes and procedures. Now that an air of uncertainty hovers around the April 7th election, counties and municipalities **will continue preparations for an April 7th election** while also preparing for potential changes that will need to be communicated to the public in a timely manner.

Voters may be confused by the situation in general, so Portage County is urging residents to closely monitor the situation and to be prepared for either scenario.
