**6. Summary of Current Actions**

April 5, 2020 @ 1800 PM Report of weekend operational periods

Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 17. 3 Positive Cases.

Testing of individuals continues based on 4-tiered testing criteria established by DHS on 03/19/2020. Priority set for testing of individuals in tier I and tier II.

PCHHS-DPH team activities:

- Weekend ICS Team – support of 2 / 4-hour operational periods.
- Entry of PUIs into WEDSS, contact with new cases to confirm self-isolation.
- Temperature monitoring of existing cases as needed
- Monitoring of PC public health mailbox for complaints.

DHS health officer calls/Sunday call with WEM at 1400

- Social distancing concerns and potential exposure concerns for WI primary election scheduled for Tuesday, April 7, 2020
- Limited amount of testing swabs coming to LHDs. Can be used with LTC facilities and coroner requests.
- DHS updating masking guidance for the general public to match CDC recommendation
- Guidance for Amish religious gatherings available from Green County HD.
- DHS will be providing additional religious gathering guidance to address drive-in services.

HHS Operations working on creating an isolation facility MOU to use with a smaller local hotel. Conversation with owner will continue 04/06/2020.

Gov. Evers Executive Order #73 – related to all-mail spring election for 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. Legislative session did not occur.

SEOC Taskforce releases surge planning framework to hospitals.

DATCP released additional guidance for selling food during emergency order #12.

DHS launches Resilient Wisconsin Initiative

Wisconsin granted Federal Disaster Declaration due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Emergency Order #12: Safer at Home translated into 7 languages.

FAQ from FEMA regarding COVID-19 and non-congregate sheltering.

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing, use Skype and telephone as much as possible.
