Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 23.

PH ICS Operations objectives:

- Timely entry and follow-up of PIF/PUI forms/follow-up of cases and contacts
- Monitoring of symptoms of residents at medium or high risk and tested for C-19
- Provide guidance and communication to the community
- Monitor for results

PH ICS Daily Briefing at 0845.

PC Virtual EOC call at 1000.

DHS COVID-19 Daily Update for Local and Tribal Health Departments.

No DHS Health Officer Forum call.

Gov. Evers announces COVID-19 volunteer program through WI Emergency Assistance Volunteer Registry (WEAVR).

WI FoodShare benefits expanded to over 215,00 households.

DHS is exempting FoodShare members who are able-bodied adults without dependents (ABAWD) from the ABAWD work requirement.

DHS increases contact tracing capabilities.

DHS updated "COVID-19: Tips for Staying Safe" document – now includes "physical distancing" and new tip related to cloth face coverings.

Updates DHS COVID-19 web pages: LTC page, provider page, higher risk page, and Forward Health page.

HHS Operations closer to securing the MOU for isolation facility. Draft of MOU completed and will be sent out to motel operator.

Safety messages: Employees should not share headsets or other objects that are near mouth or nose; employers should increase the frequency of cleaning commonly touched surfaces; employees and employers should consider pilot testing the use of face masks to ensure they do not interfere with work assignments; employers should work with facility maintenance staff to increase air exchanges in rooms; and employees should physically distance when they take breaks together and stagger breaks so they don't congregate in break rooms, and don't share food or utensils.
