Portage County Parks Covid-19 Update

April 20th, 2020

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:

The State of Wisconsin has extended the Safer at Home Order (Emergency Order #28) to May 26, 2020. To help prevent the spread of Covid-19. Under this order we will limit all campsites to members of a single household or living unit. All other private gatherings of any number of people are prohibited.

Opening

- Starting on May 1st 2020, Portage County Parks Department will open its Campgrounds at Jordan Park, Lake Emily, and Lake DuBay. Collins Park will open as Scheduled on May 15 2020. We will not be taking new reservations until June 1 2020. Those sites that are not being reserved may be taken on a first come basis through self-registration.
- Starting on May 1st Standing Rocks Disc Golf Course will also be open to the public. Daily self- registration can be done on site or season passes can be purchased on-line.

Closed

- At this time all Lodge Reservations will be cancelled through June 1st. Subject to change if needed. Those that have made a reservation will be contacted and refunded their money.
- The Dewey Shooting Range will not be open until June 1st. Subject to change.

We are asking all campers and users of our parks to please help maintain proper social distancing guidelines and avoid close contact with others. The CDC recommends a minimum of six (6) feet or distance to help reduce the risk of spread between individuals. Please follow the guidelines to help keep our parks open.
