Weekend communicable disease public health nurses will continue entering PIFs – a lot came in late today.

Request to Portage County Corporation Counsel to review request to allow dog grooming services as a curbside service under Emergency Order #28. PC Corporation Counsel opinion is to allow for as a curbside service. Formal letter of decision will be created and mailed out to local groomers next week. Will also contact United Way 2-1-1.

15 new PIFs were entered into WEDSS for 04/24/2020.
