Marshfield Clinic like Ascension not able currently to overly expand testing.

Fairfield Inn expressed interest in providing lodging at a state rate. Ray sent MOU request for consideration as an isolation facility.

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing, use Skype and telephone as much as possible. Cloth masks to be worn when going to places of essential service.
