6. Summary of Current Actions

May 3, 2020 @ 1600 PM Public Health DOC/ICS operation day 46.

Additional positive case confirmed, bringing total to 7 for Portage County.

22 new PIFs/PUIs entered into WEDSS for Saturday, 5/02/2020.

10 new PIFs/PUIs entered into WEDSS for Sunday, 05/03/2020.

No PH ICS operational period was held on Saturday, May 2, 2020. Weekend PH RN coverage maintained. On call PH RN brought in to assist with entry and follow-up.

Confirmation received back from SEOC on community-wide testing request. Drive up testing site for Portage County will be May 11-12, from 0900 to 1700 daily – at Portage County HHS. Only people with the presence of a symptom will be tested. Asymptomatic people will not be tested. 500 tests were requested. Any WI resident can come to the test site, if they have a symptom of COVID-19, to be tested.
