- Pediatric Multi-System Inflammatory Syndrome.
  1. First noted in UK
  2. Novel Syndrome
  3. Prevalent in New Jersey and New York. 93 cases 3 deaths
  4. Testing Results for SARS CO-V 2 can be positive or negative
  5. Health Alert from CDC will be released tomorrow
  6. DHS will also be putting out a Health Alert to providers, infection control, etc.
  7. All Cases will be reported to DHS
  8. DHS urges providers, PH, to not seek delay in seeking out their expert advice
- Antibody Tests: 3 primary uses 1) previously infected clients who want to donate plasma for severely ill patients 2) surveillance of population to determine prevalence (WI is currently at a rate of about 3%) and 3) research to determine amount of antibodies needed to provide immunity, and how long does the immunity last.

1445 DHS Daily CO-VID 19 Update

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing use Skype and telephone as much as possible. Cloth masks to be worn when going to places of essential service.

Hospitals	95% of hospitals affirm that they can treat all patients without crisis care.	
Hospitals	95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines.	
Health care	Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly.
