6. Summary of Current Actions

73 total investigations today (PIFS and symptom monitoring)

1 new positive case of COVID-19 confirmed for Portage County late on 05/27/2020.

Reflection: 05/27/2020 marked 14 days since EO #28: Safer At Home was dismissed by the WI Supreme Court. WI experienced its highest number of positive cases identified in one day (599), the greatest number of tests completed in one day (>10,000), and the number of deaths in one day due to COVID-19 (22).

| Cases | Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period. |  |
| Hospitals | 95% of hospitals affirm that they can treat all patients without crisis care. |  |
| Hospitals | 95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines. |  |
| Health care | Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly. |  |
