



### ORDER REINSTATING WRIT OF RESTITUTIONS

On March 23, 2020, in light of the necessary and critical efforts to minimize the risk of spreading the COV ID-19 virus by having Portage County residents remain at home as much as possible, the Court, pursuant to its equitable powers and Wis. Stat. §§ 799.44 and 753.03 the Court suspended all pending and future Writ of Restitutions until July 15, 2020, or further Order of the Court.

On March 27, Gov. Tony Evers and Wisconsin Department of Health Services Secretary Andrea Palm issued an emergency order barring landlords from serving eviction notices for renters unable to pay for 60 days. The order also blocked banks and mortgage companies from filing foreclosure actions.

On May 26, 2020, the emergency order banning most evictions and home foreclosures in Wisconsin due to the COVID-19 pandemic expired.

The Court has been advised that on June 1, 2020 the Portage County Sheriff's Office resumed previously suspended civil process.

Therefore, it is ordered that the March 23, 2020 suspension of issuance of Writ of Restitutions be lifted.
