- Recommendations – All close contacts of person with COVID 19 should be tested towards the end of their quarantine period.
- Consider using cumulative exposure when identifying contacts ex., 6 (5)minute <6 feet conversations = 30 minutes of exposure
- Guidance for asymptomatic cases that develop symptoms has changed was 10 days of isolation after specimen collection. Now if symptoms develop, 10 days of isolation after onset plus 3 well days

Contract tracing, case investigation, and monitoring continue for outbreak

Many requests for WING testing results. Final test list has not been received from WING – results calls continuing.

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing. Face masks to be worn.

Hospitals	95% of hospitals affirm that they can treat all patients without crisis care.	
Hospitals	95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines.	
Health care	Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly.
