Still getting requests for WING testing results. First of test lists was received from WING – results calls continuing. Message from WING that there was delay in contacting with results.

Safety message: All staff must maintain social distancing - 6 feet of space between and less than 10 people in a confined space. To minimize contact and maintain social distancing. Face masks to be worn.

Hospitals	95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines.	
Health care	Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly.
