Total hospitalizations of positive cases in Wisconsin at 13% with 3,177 (+17) hospitalizations. 6 hospitalizations for Portage County.

- Active Cases: 4,934 (20%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by race: American Indian (1%), Asian or Pacific Islander (4%), Black (18%), White (53%), Multiple or other races (12%), Unknown (11%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by ethnicity: Hispanic or Latino (33%), Not Hispanic or Latino (56%), Unknown (12%)
- Emergency Department visits:
  - ~ Influenza like illness: 42 visits on 6/17, compared to previous 3-day average of 34
  - ~ COVID-19 like illness: 109 visits on 6/17, compared to previous 3-day average of 124
- Total hospital bed utilization: 77%

<b>Indicator</b>	<b>Metric</b>	<b>Status</b>
Symptoms	Downward trajectory of influenza-like illnesses (ILI) reported within a 14-day period.	
Symptoms	Downward trajectory of COVID-like syndromic cases reported with a 14-day period.	
Cases	Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period.	
Hospitals	95% of hospitals affirm that they can treat all patients without crisis care.	
Hospitals	95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines.	
Health care	Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly.	

 green indicator = gating criteria met (statistically significant downward trend)

 red indicator = gating criteria not met
