Total hospitalizations of positive cases in Wisconsin at 11% with 3,726 (+43) hospitalizations. 13 total hospitalizations for Portage County, 4 current.

- Active cases: 6,302 (19%). Active cases in Portage Co.: 43 (20%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by race: American Indian (1%), Asian or Pacific Islander (4%), Black (17%), White (58%), Multiple or other races (11%), Unknown (10%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by ethnicity: Hispanic or Latino (29%), Not Hispanic or Latino (60%), Unknown (12%)
- Emergency Department visits:
 - ~Influenza like illness: 54 visits on 7/7, compared to previous 3-day average of 56
 - ~COVID-19 like illness: 207 visits on 7/7, compared to previous 3-day average of 183
- Total hospital bed utilization: 79%

Indicator	Metric	Status
Symptoms	Downward trajectory of influenza-like illnesses (ILI) reported within a 14-day period.	
Symptoms	Downward trajectory of COVID-like syndromic cases reported with a 14-day period.	
Cases	Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period.	
Hospitals	95% of hospitals affirm that they can treat all patients without crisis care.	
Hospitals	95% of all hospitals affirm that they have arranged for testing for all symptomatic clinical staff treating patients at the hospital per CDC guidelines.	
Health care	Downward trend of COVID-19 cases among health care workers calculated weekly.


