- Active cases 25,500 (18.4%). Active cases in Portage Co: 290 (17%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by race: American Indian (1%), Asian or Pacific Islander (2%), Black (9%), White (71%), Multiple or other races (8%), Unknown (9%)
- Percent of confirmed cases by ethnicity: Hispanic or Latino (16%), Not Hispanic or Latino (70%), Unknown (14%)

- COVID-19-like Illness: From the week of 9/16-9/29, Wisconsin's CLI is at medium activity with a shrinking trajectory.




