**Resolution to Adopt Public Participation Plan  
for  
Comprehensive Planning**

*WHEREAS*, the Comprehensive Planning Law, section 66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, requires the governing body of a local governmental unit to "adopt written procedures that are designed to foster public participation, including open discussion, communication programs, information services and public meetings for which advance notice has been provided, in every stage of the comprehensive plan"; and

*WHEREAS*, section 66.1001(4)(a) further requires that "The written procedures shall provide for wide distribution of proposed, alternative or amended elements of a comprehensive plan and shall provide an opportunity for written comments on the plan to be submitted by members of the public to the governing body and for the governing body to respond to such written comments";

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT* the Town Board of the Town of Sharon, Portage County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the Board, on this day, the 8 of Aug, 2001, hereby adopts the public participation guidelines entitled *Portage County Comprehensive Plan: Public Participation Plan*, dated *July 25, 2001*, attached hereto, to take effect the day after posting, and directs the Town Clerk to publish this resolution as a Class 1 notice under chapter 985, Wisconsin Statutes, and ~~to~~ post this resolution and guidelines in 3 (three) public places, in accordance with section 60.80, Wisconsin Statutes, and to make such guidelines available for public inspection.
