The Town of Amherst Plan Commission reviewed the draft plan last evening at our monthly meeting and would like to share the following comments with you:

Page 99 Plan Recommendation # 3 - Recommend stronger building codes for mobile homes such as tie down. Investigate a countywide standards for mobile homes...

Why are we not following state regulations? We felt that this issue should be regulated at the state level not at the county level.

Page 100 Plan Recommendation #4 - Recommend local municipalities to increase amount of brush and vegetation...

Many townships including ours, are strapped with budget constraints. Cost of road repair, materials, etc. greatly diminish the funds set outside to address this issue. Are there any grants available from the county or state to assist with this issue? Our town would be more than happy to increase amount of brushing if additional funds would become available.

Page 101 Plan Recommendation #6 - Work with utility companies, builders and municipalities on encouraging the burying of utility lines where feasible.

This is another money issue. It is much cheaper to use overhead rather than underground lines. Numerous maintenance issues are specific to underground lines versus overhead. Cost becomes a negating factor.

- 2) Page 73 says there are 14 dams classified as large yet on Map 18 there are 15 dams shown as large
- 3) Page 79 – says Table 28: shouldn't it be Table 34?
- 4) Map 15: Mobile Home Parks & Campgrounds – map is missing the mobile home park on Sunset Drive, approximately a mile and one half south of County Road DB. Would that also affect the number of manufactured Homes in the Town of Dewey?
- 5) Critical Community Facilities Town of Dewey – missing the Manufactured Home Park on Sunset Drive
