Election Results have been verified by Portage County Canvass Board on 11-11-14 but not yet certified by the State of Wisconsin.

County Office results have been certified by County Canvass on 11-11-14.

Election information and results for the up-coming General Election will be provided. This election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014. Portage County will have a County-wide Election consisting of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Representative in Congress – District 3, Representative to the Assembly, Districts 70, 71 & 72 (see Assembly District and Candidate link) and County Offices for Sheriff, Coroner and Clerk of Circuit Court, a state-wide referendum and two County referendums with 47 reporting units.

All races are vote for one. Crossover voting is permitted at this election.

This election will be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014. Election information and results for the up-coming election will be provided.

The election results are unofficial until the official canvass has been completed on Tuesday, November 11, 2014 and any provisional or late arriving absentee ballots have been counted.
